- Entries are only accepted from schools and groups signed up to attend the Spring Youth Concert.
- Musical selections are provided on the complimentary CD which is sent out to with all reservations.

PAINT:

- Up to three winners will be chosen for the musical selection of the Paint contest. Students' works will be projected on a screen above the orchestra during both May 7th Youth Concerts. These winners along with several honorable mentions from the painting contest will also be displayed in the lobby prior to the Tuesday night Classical concert on May 8.

POETRY:

- Two winners from the Poetry contest will be selected. Each winner will perform on stage with the PSO at either the 9:30 AM or 11:10 AM May 7th Youth Concert. Both winning poets are also required to attend the concert's rehearsal on Saturday, May 5 at 2:00 PM.

Medium: 8.5" x 11" white paper
(typed or printed clearly)

Entries must be the original work of an individual student. Attach an entry form securely to the back of the work. Anonymous entries will not be accepted. All entries become the property of the PSO. The Portland Symphony Orchestra is not responsible for lost or damaged entries.
